
Surviving an Active Shooter

Background of an Active Shooter



- An active shooter is a person who actively engages in shooting or attempting to kill people in a small, crowded space, usually with a firearm.
- Happens unexpectedly and chooses victims in a random manner.

What to do when...

AN ACTIVE SHOOTER OCCUR IN THE VICINITY?




- Run leave everything behind except your phone and go to the nearest exits or place away from the shooter with your hands visible.
- Hide "Out of sight, out of mind". Find a place to hide and secure the entrance with locks and heavy objects. Keep devices in silent mode and text/call 911 when it's safe to do so.
- Fight when faced with danger, try to incapacitate the shooter by hitting vital body parts, throwing objects, or disabling vision. Act fast and with aggression.

2 LAW ENFORCEMENT ARRIVES



- Stay calm and cooperate with them by keeping your hands visible, dropping things you hold, and keep asking for help.
- Avoid acting rashly such as running toward officers.

3. (PRONE TO ACTIVE SHOOTER)



- Recognize the threats that may exist in your area.
- Be familiar with the two nearest exits in the area.
- Stay put and lock the door when in an office.
- As a last resort, try to take down the gunman.
